





IDEA GENERATOR

Here is your Idea Generator - our own version of a traditional paper fortune teller. It's filled with creative themes to enthuse and inspire your pupils.

FOLDING THE IDEA GENERATOR








- 1. Fold two opposite diagonal corners together, then open back up.
- 2. Fold the other two corners together, then open back up.
- 3. Turn the colour printed paper side down. Fold all four corners to the centre of the paper.







- 4. When all four corners are folded, it should look like this!
- 5. Flip the paper over then fold the corners into the centre again.
- 6. When all four corners are folded, it should look like this!







- 7. Fold two sides together ensuring the numbers are on the inside. then open back up.
- 8. Fold the other side together.
- 9. Slide your thumbs and index fingers under the four flaps.
- 10. Rotate your hands bringing your thumbs and index fingers together. The Idea Generator will then expand and the numbers will disappear inside.

HOW TO USE

- 1. A pupil picks a theme.
- 2. Spell it out while you open the Idea Generator back and forth.
- 3. Then have them pick a number and open and close the Idea Generator counting that number out. Repeat.
- 4. Have them pick a third and final number, then lift the flap and it will reveal a theme/idea for the pupil to write about.
