ACTIVITY

Step 1 Creating interest (5 mins)	Get your pupils engaged with this activity by watching the This Is Me video, which introduces them to this activity.
Step 2 Vision / Mood Board (25 mins)	Each pupil needs a mood board student activity sheet (alternatively, a piece of paper or they can create one online by dropping images into a Word doc). Ask pupils to spend 15 minutes sourcing images that represent who they are such as their likes and dislikes, their goals and dreams, what they're passionate about etc. Then allow 10 minutes to arrange and stick their images on their sheet, and if they want to jot down any words to represent them that they couldn't find an image for, encourage this. There is also a poem writing activity to complement this activity online too.
