By Post:

- Pupils write their poems or mini sagas, hand them in, you then complete the teacher entry form (download one online)

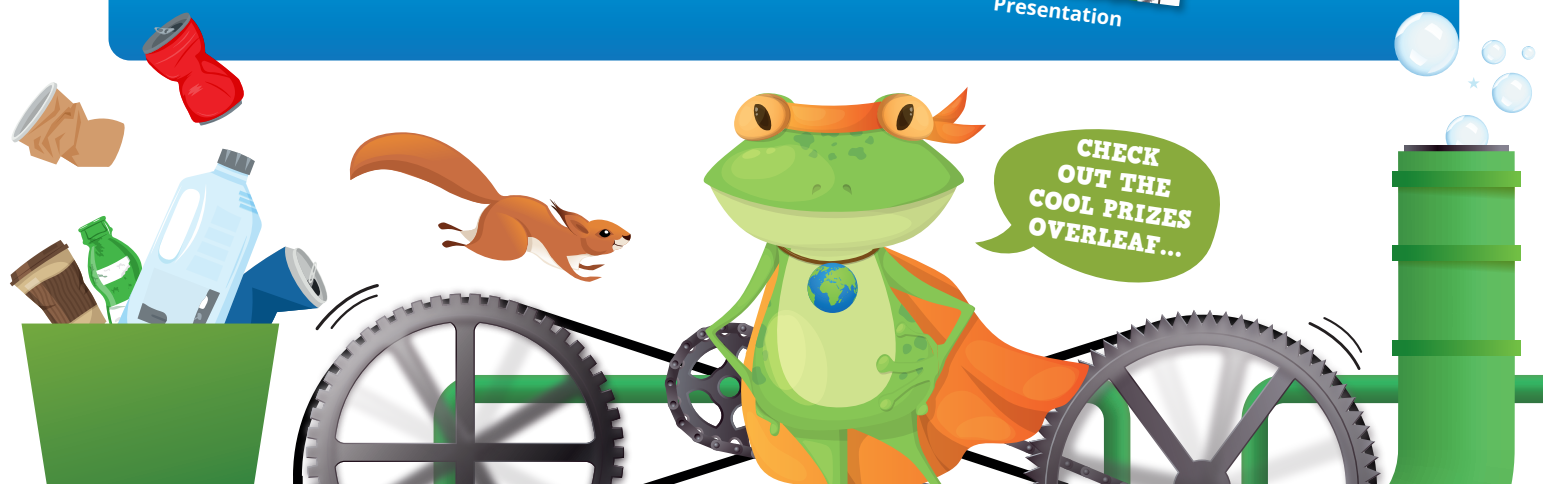

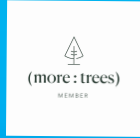


For Pupils

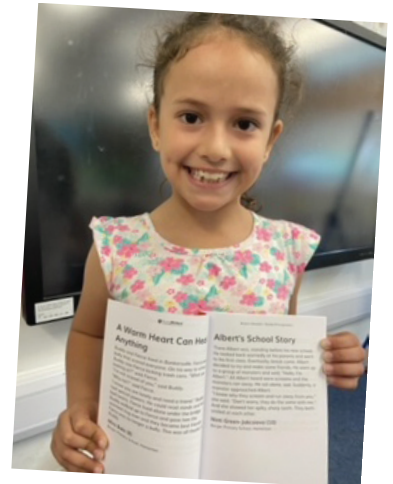
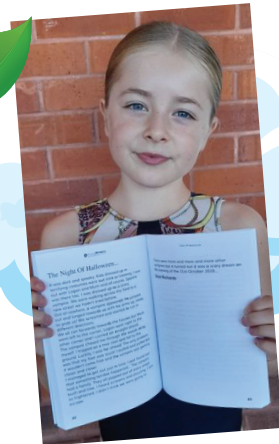
