Climate change – a drastic change in the world's temperatures and weather caused by human activity

Deforestation – cutting down lots of trees in a forest

Dreams – strong hopes or wishes

Drought – a long time with no rain

Earth – the planet we live on

Endangered – a species that is close to being wiped out

Environment – the air, water and land where people, animals and plants live

Extinct – no longer alive, especially a type of animal

Habitat – the natural home of an animal or plant

Help – to rescue or aid someone or something

Life cycle – the stages an animal or plant goes through as it grows and develops

Nature – the world and living things that are not made by people

Plastic – a long-lasting, man-made material that is used in many different ways **Pollution** – poison or waste materials that damage the environment

Protect – to keep safe, to shield from danger

Rainforest – a thick forest found in tropical places that gets lots of rain all year, home to lots of different plants and animals

Recycle – to reuse something, either as it is or by changing it into something new

Renewable – a source of energy that cannot be used up, or can be replaced e.g. wind, solar

Save – rescue from harm or danger

Solar – powered by the sun

Species – a group of animals of the same type e.g. dogs, elephants

Wildfire – a fire in the wild that is out of control

Wildlife – animals that live in the wild, free of humans
